(a)

- 1. One way to introduce CSS is through the internal style sheet. This places the CSS code within the head section of your html file.
- 2. The second way is external style sheet where you place the CSS code in a separate file with the .CSS extension. Your HTML file can refer to this CSS file using a link rel.
- 3. The third way is the inline style sheet which is in your HTML file. It is defined within an HTML element.

(b)

- 1. CSS has many measurement units. These units can be categorized into two types. Absolute length units and Relative length units. Absolute length units have a fixed length no matter the screen size. Relative length units describe the length relation or proportion to the screen size or an element size. They adjust accordingly.
- 2. Selectors in CSS select a html element or a group of them to style on a web page.
- 3. A property is an aspect of html elements that can be modified within CSS.
- 4. Values are assigned to properties and can modify it.
